



## Tymon Zieliński

Professor

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Professor Tymon Zieliński is the leader of the CORE – Climate and Ocean Research and Education team at the Institute of Oceanology of the Polish Academy of Sciences (IO PAN) in Sopot. Tymon Zieliński is an active researcher, co-author of over 100 peer-reviewed scientific articles and over 200 conference presentations and is also active in the publishing process as a thematic editor in international journals, including *Frontiers in Marine Science*, *Atmosphere*, *Oceanologia* or *Sustainability*.

Between 2016 and 2020, Tymon Zieliński was representing Central-Eastern Europe at the board for the Regular Process for Global Reporting and Assessment of the State of the Marine Environment. In 2019, Tymon became a member of the Steering Committee of the European Marine Board Communication Panel, while between 2020 and 2022 he chaired the EU4Ocean Coalition Climate and Ocean Working Group. Tymon Zieliński gave a plenary speech dedicated to ocean education at the UN Ocean Conference, which was held in Lisbon in 2022.

Tymon Zieliński participates in scientific and educational projects in the field of studying the processes occurring in the ocean-atmosphere system and related to climate change, with particular emphasis on sustainable development. From the beginning of his professional career, Tymon has been involved in educational activities, both in formal and non-formal teaching. At IO PAN, Tymon Zieliński is the head of the Doctoral School and the coordinator of the GeoPlanet Doctoral School.

In recognition of his scientific, organizational and educational achievements, Tymon Zieliński became, in 2021, the "face" of the European action on Research Integrity and was also awarded a title of a Green Hero by BNP Paribas for climate research and education.
