
Information Clause on the Processing of Personal Data of Participants of Information Day “Last Hop-On Facility Call: How and Why Polish Partners Can Join Horizon Europe Projects – Perspectives of Consortium Coordinators and Partners (HORIZON-WIDERA-2026-03-WIDENING-01)” (18.06.2026, online)

In accordance with the information obligation under the requirements of Article 13(1) and (2) of Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46/EC (General Data Protection Regulation) hereinafter referred to as GDPR, we inform you that:

1. The controller of the personal data of the participant of the **Information Day “Last Hop-On Facility Call: How and Why Polish Partners Can Join Horizon Europe Projects – Perspectives of Consortium Coordinators and Partners (HORIZON-WIDERA-2026-03-WIDENING-01)” (18.06.2026, online)** is the National Centre for Research and Development (hereinafter: "NCBR").

You can contact the data protection officer on all matters related to the processing of personal data at NCBR and the exercise of your rights under GDPR.

4. Your personal data will be processed in connection with your participation in the **Information Day “Last Hop-On Facility Call: How and Why Polish Partners Can Join Horizon Europe Projects – Perspectives of Consortium Coordinators and Partners (HORIZON-WIDERA-2026-03-WIDENING-01)” (18.06.2026, online)** The legal basis for the processing of data is Article 6(1)(e) GDPR, in connection with the Act of 30 April 2010 on the National Centre for Research and Development.

5. The recipients to whom your personal data may be disclosed are entities authorized to process them based on law or based on a contract concluded with NCBR. A separate category of recipients to whom your personal data may be disclosed are entities supporting the controller in exercising rights and obligations and providing services, e.g., NCBR+ Sp. z o.o. Also, an unlimited circle of recipients in the scope of information and promotional activities related to the event you will participate in, in connection with the disclosure of your personal data on the NCBR website, NCBR social media channels (LinkedIn and Facebook) - with access to an unlimited circle of recipients using the indicated social media or websites. Additionally, your data will be disclosed to the provider of the online training platform **Microsoft Teams**.

6. Your personal data will be processed in connection with participation in the event. The data will then be stored indefinitely for archival purposes, in accordance with the Unified Material List of Records of the National Centre for Research and Development.

7. Under the terms specified by GDPR, you have the right to request from the controller:

- a) Access to your personal data.
- b) Rectification (correction) of your personal data.
- c) Object to the processing of your personal data.
- d) Erasure of your personal data or restriction of their processing.

8. If you believe that the processing of your personal data violates the provisions on data protection, you have the right to lodge a complaint with the supervisory authority, which is the President of the Personal Data Protection Office (President of the Personal Data Protection Office, 00-014 Warsaw, ul. Moniuszki 1A, tel. 22 531 03 00) or another supervisory authority, particularly in the member state of your habitual residence, place of work, or place of the alleged infringement.

9. Providing data is voluntary but necessary to participate in the event.
